- 1. Abstract (30 lines)
- 2. Research Plan (5 pages, including figures)
  - a. Hypotheses and Specific Aims (~1 page)
  - b. Background and Significance (~1 page)
  - c. Preliminary Results (~1 page)
  - d. Research Design and Methods (~3 pages) discuss potential difficulties and alternate approaches. Address statistical considerations and translational potential.
- 3. Career Development // Training in Clinical and Laboratory Research (1 page)
  - a. Describe advisory committee for proposed research and career development
  - b. Planned courses, conferences, meetings
  - c. Other experiences that will enhance career
- 4. Time Frame (provide estimated milestones)
- 5. Literature cited (no page limit)

6. <u>One-year Budget</u> The budget for the CEP Award is \$100,000: \$25,000 direct dollars are from NIH funds (institutional IDC may be applied) & \$75,000 direct dollars are from institutional/philanthropic funds (no IDC permitted on these funds). Please obtain an IDC waiver if required by your institution to accept the award should you be selected. Please submit your budget using the budget template provided.
